



Offaly Bike Week 2019

Offaly Sports Partnership on behalf of Offaly County Council delivered a range of activities funded by the Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport in support of Bike Week 2019 which took place from the 22nd to 30th June 2019

Activities delivered included: -



Tandem cycling for people with visual impairments

(supported by National Council for the Blind in Ireland Offaly (NCBI), Wolftrap Cycling Club, Tullamore Cycling & Touring Club, and Lough Boora Parklands)

10 people with visual impairments in addition to three guide pilots participated

Lough Boora Discovery Park school cycle days



Supported by Offaly Sports Partnership, these cycle days were held in Lough Boora Parklands

High Street Belmont brought 75 children to the school cycle day; while Banagher Youthreach brought 15 young people at risk to the cycle days

School bike checks

In preparation for lunchtime cycles in Birr, two schools were offered free bike checks by Buckley Cycles for pupils' bikes.
