

Competition – Welcome Sticker Terms and Conditions

Eligibility:

To enter, you must be under 25 years of age by Monday January 14th 2019.

No submission fee is required.

To accompany the design you must complete and sign the application form containing your full name, region/town, phone number, email and a brief explanation of your design and attach it securely to the artwork that you submit. PLEASE NOTE THAT WHERE ARTWORK IS SUBMITTED WITHOUT THE RELEVANT APPLICATION FORM BEING COMPLETED, IT WILL NOT PROGRESS TO THE JUDGING STAGE OF THE COMPETITION.

All entries together with the artists' details (name, age, school or town) may be used in publicity campaigns. Photographs of the winners together with their names and ages may be used in publicity campaigns where the parents or guardians of the winners have given their consent.

The Judging Panel is responsible for the allocation of prizes and the decision of the Chairperson of the Judging Panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding that decision.

The brief:

To design an LGBTI+ welcome sticker to be displayed in sports clubs, cultural bodies, arts organisations, youth groups and businesses to declare their support for the LGBTI+ community and ensure they feel welcome in their establishment. The design should reflect the LGBTI+ National Youth Strategy mission of "visible, valued and included".

Designs can be hand-drawn or computer-drawn. The design must be original and should not be bigger than A5.

Only one entry per person is permitted. No group entries will be accepted.

The winning design may be printed on different promotional materials. DCYA reserves the right to make changes to the design selected as the winner.

The shortlisted applicants will be informed by the end of January 2019 and invited to an award ceremony due to take place in mid-February 2019, where the winner will be announced.

There will be a prize of a €400 One4all voucher for the overall winner and there will also be runner up prizes.
