Disability awareness training

Following the success of the 2014 pilot, two additional disability awareness training sessions were delivered to 40 students from one post primary school. As in 2014, TY students were exposed to disability awareness training / inclusive games; and went on to put their skills into practice by working with primary schools with special needs units culminating in an inter schools sports day

Disability games and activities

Similar to the disability awareness training delivered to post primary schools, this training was delivered to care services to assist their staff in delivering physical activity sessions for people with disabilities

Disability awareness training

Following requests from post primary schools to include a module on sport and people with disabilities, Offaly Sports Partnership piloted disability awareness training in one post primary school for 28 students. TY students were exposed to disability awareness training / inclusive games as part of their 2014 / 2015 TY modules.

Following the training, students were encouraged to put their skills into practice and worked with primary schools with special needs units to deliver a programme of activities which culminated in an inter schools sports day.
