

Offaly Bike Week 2011

Bike Week 2011 took place from Saturday 17th to Sunday 25th June with cycling events all over the country, organised by local authorities, community groups, charities and cycling groups.

Events delivered in conjunction with national and local clubs / organisations, and schools, as part of Bike Week 2011 included:-

Five bike shops throughout Offaly conducted **free bike checks** for the general public.

Cycle to School days were held in two primary schools in the county on the 20th June. Over 85 students from St. Brendan's in Birr and Ballybryant in Rhode participated on the day for which advanced cycling and safety training had been given provided prior to Bike Week.



Birr Bike Week supported by Wolftrap Cycling Club

Wolftrap Cycling Club offered a range of activities as part of Offaly Bike Week 2012 including: -

- Novice meet and spin held on the 20th June. Over 10 novices took to their bikes

- Family Fun Cycle Day held in Birr on the 25th June. This event also incorporated tandem cycling for people with disabilities
